



Checking Out Audiobooks on your Kindle® Fire via OverDrive

- Be sure you have a Shenandoah County Library card in good standing.
- Be sure your device is connected to the Internet.
- At present, the Kindle® Fire can only download and play MP3 audiobooks checked out via the OverDrive Media Console. **WMA files are not supported.**
- Before browsing for and checking out materials, the OverDrive Media Console application must be installed on your Kindle® Fire. This installation in turn requires that a change be made to your device's settings.
- To begin, click the "Settings" icon in the upper-right corner of the Kindle® screen. This icon resembles a small gear. On the subsequent screen, select "More," then "Device." For the menu option "Allow Installation of Applications from Unknown Sources," select "On." (You may reset this option to "Off" once the installation process is complete). Click "OK" on any subsequent screen.
- Navigate to the following Web site to download the OverDrive application: <http://overdrive.com/Software/omc/> Select "Android" as your operating system, then select the following link, which appears immediately below your selection: ***If your device doesn't support Android Market, you can download OverDrive Media Console for Android from OverDrive.*** Click "Agree" on the subsequent screen. The download and installation will proceed.
- Open the OverDrive Media Console, and begin browsing for audiobooks by selecting the "Menu" icon, and clicking "Get Books." If prompted, enter "Shenandoah County Library" as your member library.
