



## **Basye Foreign Film Festival**

### ***Thursdays in March at the Basye/Orkney Springs Public Library***

Step out of the cold and into another world every Thursday afternoon in March by seeing an award-winning film from another land at the second annual Basye Foreign Film Festival at the Basye/Orkney Springs Public Library.

Showing at 3 p.m. March 7, 14, 21 and 28 will be Academy Award– or Golden Globe–recognized films from Denmark, Italy, Argentina and France. The films are shown in their original language with English subtitles, and the matinee showings are free to the public.

#### **The lineup\*:**

- March 7: A popular and critically acclaimed Danish film that was an Oscar runner-up for best foreign language film in 2007. It is being remade by Hollywood.
- March 14: A dark satire on official corruption from Italy. This 1971 Oscar winner has become a classic.
- March 21: The 1986 Golden Globe– and Oscar-winner is a powerful conscience-awakening film made in the aftermath of Argentina's dirty war.
- March 28: A wildly popular French film that drew Academy Award attention in 2005 for its musical score as well as for best foreign language film.
